- \Rightarrow A student must earn <u>at least 60 semester hours</u>, excluding physical activity courses, at a baccalaureate degree granting institution.
- \Rightarrow A Student must earn <u>at least 124 credit hours</u> that apply to an ECU Bachelor's degree.
